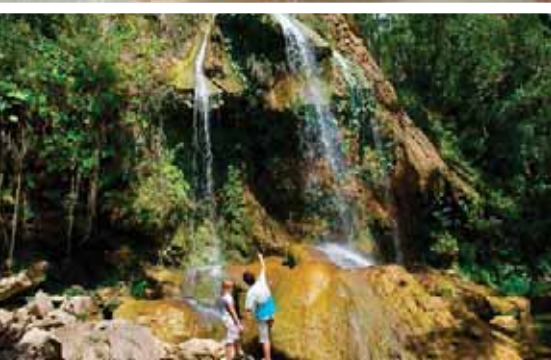

HAVANA

BAHIA DE NIPE
